There are three political parties in Genovia: Party A ('A'), Party B ('B') and Party C ('C'). Before last month's General Election 'B' held 63 of the 120 seats in the Genovian Parliament, the 'A' held 40 and the 'C' held 17.

In last month's General Election:

- 'A' gained 24 seats from the 'B' and 5 seats from the 'C';
- 'B' gained 6 seats from 'A' and 8 seats from the 'C';
- 'C' gained 9 seats from 'A' and 16 seats from 'B'.

Which one of the following pie charts, suitably labelled, shows the current state of the parties in the Genovian Parliament?
