

Decision Making



22 Oranges are more expensive than pomegranates, which are more expensive than durians. Cherries are more expensive than durians. Oranges are less expensive than watermelons.

Which of the following are true?

- A** Watermelons are less expensive than durians.
- B** Cherries may be less expensive than pomegranates
- C** Watermelon is more expensive than pomegranates
- D** Pomegranates and cherries are the same price
- E** Oranges and cherries are the same price



Answer: Durian < pomegranates < oranges < watermelon

Cherries are more expensive than durian but we don't know how expensive relative to the other fruits.

B and C are the only true statements.
